HISTORICALLY HIP

Ever since Penang was named a UNESCO World Heritage site, it's become a hotbed for heritage boutique properties such as Clove Hall, Muntri Mews and the Blue Mansion. The latest on the scene is Macalister Mansion, designed by Colin Seah of Singapore's Ministry of Design. Named after former British governor Colonel Norman Macalister, the century-old building and now eight-room hotel doubles as a living museum. Its wrought iron staircase in the turret room (that's Room 4) has been beautifully restored and each room features paintings by Southeast Asian artists depicting various stages of the colonel's life. designhotels.com/macalister_mansion
